Senate Bill 705

- 1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding a new section,
2 designated §29A-3B-13, relating to allowing the Board of Education to promulgate rules for
3 submission to the Legislature.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 3B. STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION RULE MAKING.

§29A-3B-13. Board of Education to promulgate rules; submission to Legislature.

- 1 Under its supervisory duties, the West Virginia Board of Education may promulgate rules
2 or policies which shall be submitted to the Legislature for its review and approval, amendment, or
3 rejection, in whole or in part, in the manner prescribed by general law.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill allows the Board of Education promulgate rules for submission to the Legislature.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
