1	A BILL to amend and reenact §16-5K-6 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
2	to professional services provided to the West Virginia Birth-to-Three program by therapists
3	and other professionals who are not employed by a state agency; and providing a 25
4	percent increase payment for those services.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

## ARTICLE 5K. EARLY INTERVENTION SERVICES FOR CHILDREN WITH DEVELOPMENTAL DELAYS.

1	(a) There is created in the state Treasury a fund to be known as the "West Virginia Birth-to-					
2	Three Fund" that shall be an interest-bearing account established and maintained to pay costs,					
3	fees and expenses incurred, or to be incurred, for early intervention services for children who are					
4	developmentally delayed.					
5	(b) Funds deposited into this account shall be derived from the following sources:					
6	(1) Any appropriations by the Legislature;					
7	(2) Fund transfers from any fund of the divisions of the Department of Health that, in whole					
8	or in part, supports early intervention services;					
9	(3) All p	ublic funds transferre	ed by any public ager	ncy as permitted by applic	able law;	
10	(4) Any private funds contributed, donated or bequeathed by corporations, individuals or					
11	other entities; and					
12	(5) All p	roceeds from fees p	aid by the client or thi	rd party payers; and		
13	(6) All ir	nterest or return on ir	nvestments accruing	to the fund.		
14	(c) Mon	eys deposited in this	s fund shall be used	exclusively to provide ear	rly intervention	
15	services to acco	omplish the purpose	s of this article. Exper	nditures of moneys deposi	ted in this fund	
16	are to be made	in accordance with a	appropriation by the L	egislature and in accordar	nce with §12-3-	
17	1 et seq. of this	s code and upon the	e fulfillment of the pro	ovisions of §5A-2-1 et sec	q. of this code:

- 18 Provided, That for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2003, expenditures are authorized from deposits
- 19 rather than pursuant to appropriation by the Legislature. <u>Beginning July 1, 2025, therapists and</u>

20 other professionals, who are not employees of any state agency, who have been contracted to

- 21 provide services to the Birth-to-Three program, shall receive a 25 percent increase in payments
- 22 for services provided.
- 23 (d) Any balance remaining in this fund at the end of any state fiscal year shall not revert to
- 24 the state Treasury but shall remain in this fund and shall be used only in a manner consistent with
- this article.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to increase payment for professional service provided to the West Virginia Birth-to-Three program by therapists and other professionals who are not employed by a state agency by 25 percent.
