1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding a new section,
2 designated §5-10D-15, relating to personally identifiable information of a member, retirant,
3 beneficiary, or alternate payee of a retirement system administered by the Consolidated
4 Public Retirement Board being confidential and exempt from disclosure.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 10D. CONSOLIDATED PUBLIC RETIREMENT BOARD.

§5-10D-15. Confidential information exempt from disclosure.

1 Due to the increased risk of fraud and personal identity theft, all information contained in
2 the records maintained by the Consolidated Public Retirement Board for all retirement systems
3 administered pursuant to this article that would tend to disclose personally identifiable information
4 of a member, retirant, beneficiary, or alternate payee are confidential and exempt from disclosure
5 under the provisions of §29B-1-1 et seq. of this code. This information includes, without limitation,
6 Social Security numbers, account numbers, dates of birth, addresses, telephone numbers, e-mail
7 addresses, medical or disability information, direct deposit information, and any other personally
8 identifiable information. Members, retirants, beneficiaries, alternate payees, or persons
9 authorized by them, are permitted access to their own information.
