1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding a new section,
2 designated §17-16A-29A, relating to requiring EZ-Passes to be transferrable among
3 vehicles owned by the same licensee.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 16A. WEST VIRGINIA PARKWAYS AUTHORITY.

§17-16A-29A. West Virginia EZ Pass transponders must be assigned to individual drivers.

1 (a) EZ Passes issued to individual licensed drivers may be transferred among up to 5
2 vehicles of the same West Virginia Parkways Authority (WVPEDTA) vehicle class owned by that
3 same licensee.

4 (b) To participate in such transferal, all such vehicles must be enrolled with the EZ Pass
5 program.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require EZ-Passes to be assigned to individual drivers and not automobiles.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
