1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding a new section,
2 designated §20-2-65, relating to permitting gold panning; and providing for the publishing
3 of dates.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 2. WILDLIFE RESOURCES.

<u>§20-2-65.</u>	<u>Gold-panning</u>	<u>permitted;</u>	<u>dates</u>	<u>published.</u>
1	(a) The Division of Natural Resources shall authorize gold panning in West Virginia rivers			
2	and streams and shall designate times of year when gold panning is permissible depending in the			
3	spawning season on various rivers and streams in the state.			
4	(b) A gold pan shall be used and a sluice that is no bigger than four inches wide.			
5	(c) After the establishment of the dates when gold panning is permitted, the Division of			
6	Natural Resources shall publish these dates for the interested public.			

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize gold panning and have dates published showing when the season is open.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
