1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding a new section,
2 designated §17-4-56, relating to requiring the Commissioner of Highways to include
3 rumble strips on double-yellow lined roads and highways.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 4. STATE ROAD SYSTEM.

§17-4-56. Rumble strips required on double-yellow lined roads.

1 (a) The commissioner shall require the placement of rumble strips on all double-yellow
2 lined roads and highways.

3 (b) Not later than July 1, 2026, the commissioner shall develop a plan by which rumble
4 strips shall be placed on all double-yellow lined roads and highways. Implementation of such plan
5 shall commence not later than September 1, 2026, and shall be completed not later than June 30,
6 2036.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require rumble strips on double-yellow lined roads.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law
and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
