1 A BILL supplementing and amending the appropriations of public moneys out of the Treasury from
2 the balance of moneys remaining as an unappropriated balance in the State Fund, General
3 Revenue, to the Bureau of Senior Services, Bureau of Senior Services, fund 0420 fiscal
4 year 2026, organization 0508 by adding a new item of appropriation for the fiscal year
5 ending June 30, 2026.

1 WHEREAS, The Governor submitted the Executive Budget Document to the Legislature
2 on January 14, 2026, containing a statement of the State Fund, General Revenue, setting forth
3 therein the cash balance as of July 1, 2025, and further included the estimate of revenue for the
4 fiscal year 2026, less net appropriation balances forwarded and regular and surplus
5 appropriations for the fiscal year 2026, and further included recommended supplemental
6 appropriations from the balance of the State Fund, General Revenue; and

7 WHEREAS, It appears from the Governor's Statement of the State Fund, General
8 Revenue, there now remains an unappropriated balance in the Treasury which is available for
9 appropriation during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2026; therefore

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

1 That the total appropriation for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2026, to fund 0420, fiscal
2 year 2026, organization 0508, be supplemented and amended by adding a new item of
3 appropriation as follows:
