1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding a new section,  
 2 designated §46A-2-129b, relating to prohibiting unsolicited robocalls for sales and charity  
 3 donations.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 2. CONSUMER CREDIT PROTECTION.**

**§46A-2-129b. Unsolicited robocalls and sales calls.**

1 No telemarketer using an auto-dialing system or "robo-calling" system shall place a  
 2 telephone call or otherwise communicate by telephone with a consumer or third party, at any  
 3 place, including a place of employment, to sell or propose the sale of an insurance-related,  
 4 warranty-related, or to solicit donations to charities or any charitable donation-related causes in  
 5 this state.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to prohibit unsolicited robocalls for sales and charity donations.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
