1 A BILL to amend and reenact the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding a new
 2 section §1-8-2, relating to prohibiting government entities from disclosing information that
 3 will be used for the enforcement of federal immigration law in certain circumstances.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

**ARTICLE 8. RESTRICTIONS ON POWERS OF STATE AGENICES AND POLITICAL
 SUBDIVISIONS.**

**§1-8-2. Restriction on disclosing information to be used for enforcement of federal
 immigration laws.**

1 (a) As used in this section:

2 "Government entity" means any state, county, or municipal department, bureau, division,
 3 section, board, commission, trustee, authority, or officer, created by the constitution, statute, or
 4 agency action.

5 "Personal information" means information that identifies an individual, including the
 6 individual's photograph or image, name, address, driver license number, Social Security number,
 7 telephone number, digitized signature, or medical information. Personal information includes any
 8 information pertaining to an individual's criminal history, and any list, dataset, or aggregated data
 9 that contains information described in this subdivision.

10 (b) Before providing any personal information to a person, a government entity shall
 11 require that the person provide the government entity with all of the following, as applicable:

12 (1) The person's name or the name of the entity on whose behalf the person is requesting
 13 the personal information, as applicable.

14 (2) Contact information for the person.

15 (3) A statement by the person, under penalty of perjury, about whether the person is
 16 requesting the personal information for the purpose of enforcing federal immigration law.

17 (4) If the person states under subsection (c) that the request for personal information is for

18 the purpose of enforcing federal immigration law, a statement about whether the person has a
19 judicial warrant for that personal information issued by a federal court or a court of this state.

20 (c) If a person indicates that the personal information will be used for the purpose of
21 enforcing federal immigration law as described in subsection (1), or if the government entity has
22 reason to believe the personal information will be used for the purpose of enforcing federal
23 immigration law, the government entity shall not provide any personal information to the person
24 unless the person presents a warrant for the personal information issued by a federal court or a
25 court of this state.

26 (d) By not later than December 31, 2026, and each December 31 thereafter, each
27 government entity shall provide a report to the attorney general and the legislature containing the
28 following information for the previous calendar year:

29 (1) The amount of requests the government entity received for personal information to be
30 used for the purpose of enforcing federal immigration law.

31 (2) The number of requests described in subdivision (a) granted or denied by the
32 government entity.

33 (3) Any other information requested by the attorney general or the legislature.

34 (e) If a government entity that provided personal information to a person determines that
35 the person used the personal information for the purpose of enforcing federal immigration law in
36 violation of section 3, government entities shall not provide any personal information to that
37 person, or to the entity on whose behalf the person requested the personal information, unless
38 obligated by a warrant issued by a federal court or a court of this state.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to limit the information given by government agencies for the purpose of enforcing federal immigration laws.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
