1 A BILL to repeal §62-15A-1, §62-15A-2, and §62-15A-3 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as  
2 amended, relating to repealing the Addiction Treatment Pilot Program to repeal all portions  
3 of the legislation as the pilot program no longer exists.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 15A. ADDICTION TREATMENT PILOT PROGRAM.**

**§62-15A-1. Definitions.**

**§62-15A-2. The Department of Military Affairs and Public Safety Drug Addiction Treatment Program.**

**§62-15A-3. Annual reports.**
