1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding a new section,
 2 designated §20-5-20, relating to providing a 20 percent discount for golf green fees at state
 3 parks for West Virginia residents on low play days.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 5. PARKS AND RECREATION.

§20-5-20. Green fee discount for West Virginia residents.

1 (a) The director shall provide to West Virginia residents a 20 percent discount at all state
 2 parks that have golf courses on low play days of Mondays, Tuesdays, and Wednesdays..

3 (b) The director shall propose rules for legislative approval in accordance with the §29A-3-
 4 1 et seq. of this code to implement the provisions of subsection (a) of this section. The rules shall
 5 include the requirement that residents desiring to use the greens on the stated days have a valid
 6 driver's license or Real ID. The director may exclude traditional peak periods of occupancy at
 7 state parks from the provisions of subsection (a) of this section, and may otherwise place
 8 reasonable limits on the use of the golf courses at state parks pursuant to subsection (a) of this
 9 section.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to provide a 20 percent discount for golf green fees at state parks for West Virginia residents on certain days.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
