Senate Bill 1067

1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding a new section,
 2 designated §18-3-14, relating to creating an extended child care program for parents of
 3 elementary children, supervised by adults and paid for by parents of children in the
 4 schools.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 3. STATE SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS.

§18-3-14. Extended daycare program for parents of elementary schools.

1 The state superintendent shall establish an Extended Daycare program for parents of
 2 elementary children to be held on the elementary campuses of schools. The program hours shall
 3 be from the end of the school day until 6:00 p.m. The program shall provide for supervision of the
 4 students by adults who are paid for by the parents who have children in these schools.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to create an extended childcare program for elementary schools, supervised by adults who are paid by parents of the children.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
