### **Senate Bill 215**

1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding a new article,  
2 designated §18-36-1, relating to education; and creating the West Virginia Constitutional  
3 Schools Act of 2026.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 36. WEST VIRGINIA CONSTITUTIONAL SCHOOLS ACT OF 2026.**

**§18-36-1. Establishment of act.**

1 (a) Schools in this state shall designate a time each day for prayer or meditation and  
2 announce such at the beginning of each day in keeping with the West Virginia Bill of Rights.

3 (b) At the beginning of each school day, instruction shall include both the Pledge of  
4 Allegiance to the Flag of the United States, and to the Flag of the State of West Virginia, which  
5 shall state the following: "I pledge allegiance to the flag of West Virginia, which serves as a  
6 constant reminder that 'Mountaineers are always Free,' which stands as a symbol of her majestic  
7 mountains, fertile forests, rich veins of coal, and the pride of her people."

8 (c) At outset of each school year, students and parents shall be supplied with a copy of the  
9 West Virginia Constitution, and the preamble shall be read at least twice, once on two separate  
10 days, during the first week over the intercom.

11 (d) Beginning with the 2026/2027 school year, schools shall remove the mandatory West  
12 Virginia Department of Education "Next Generation" standards and provide choice with suggested  
13 classical curriculum standards for districts to decide according to their leadership, community  
14 priorities, and educational philosophy, or, allow districts to establish their own standards which fit  
15 their strategic plans, and submit both to LOCEA, not for approval, but for policy research and  
16 records.

17 (e) Schools shall remove mandatory state general summative assessment testing and  
18 replace these methods with strategic testing choice at the district level.

19 (f) The county board of education shall allow schools and districts to adopt testing policies  
20 which serve the needs of their pupils.

21        (g) County boards of education shall limit statewide testing to a statistical random sample  
22        in each district for policy research purposes.

23        (h) County boards of education shall offer a range of testing services such as the SAT or  
24        CLT (Classical Learning Test) for parents wishing to know how their child is performing on national  
25        norm-references tests.

26        (i) This act shall be known and cited as the "the West Virginia Constitutional Schools Act of  
27        2026."

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to provide for the creation of the West Virginia Constitutional Schools Act of 2026.
