- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-6-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to
2 authorizing the West Virginia State Police to promulgate a legislative rule relating to the
3 West Virginia State Police Member Grievance Procedure.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

**ARTICLE 6. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY TO
PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64- 6 - 1. West Virginia State Police.

- 1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 23, 2025, authorized under the
2 authority of §15-2-6 of this code, modified by the West Virginia State Police to meet the objections
3 of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on September
4 24, 2025, relating to the West Virginia State Police (West Virginia State Police Member Grievance
5 Procedure, [81 CSR 08](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the State Police to promulgate a legislative rule relating to West Virginia State Police Member Grievance Procedure.
