- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-7-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to
2 authorizing the Tax Department to promulgate a legislative rule relating to a tax credit for
3 providing vehicles to low-income workers.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

**ARTICLE 7. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE TO PROMULGATE
LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-7-1. Tax Department.

- 1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on March 31, 2025, authorized under the
2 authority of §11-13FF-5 of this code, modified by the Tax Department to meet the objections of the
3 Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on August 26, 2025,
4 relating to the Tax Department (tax credit for providing vehicles to low-income workers, [110 CSR](#)
5 [13FF](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Tax Department to promulgate a legislative rule relating to tax credit for providing vehicles to low-income workers.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
