### **Senate Bill 359**

- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to  
2 authorizing the Board of Pharmacy to promulgate a legislative rule relating to mail-order  
3 and nonresident pharmacies.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS BOARDS AND AGENCIES TO  
PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64- 9 - 1. Board of Pharmacy.**

- 1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 24, 2025, authorized under the  
2 authority of §30-5-7 of this code, modified by the Board of Pharmacy to meet the objections of the  
3 Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on October 22, 2025,  
4 relating to the Board of Pharmacy (mail-order and non-resident pharmacies, [15 CSR 06](#)), is  
5 authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Pharmacy to promulgate a legislative rule relating to mail-order and non-resident pharmacies.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
