1 A BILL to amend and reenact §50-1-3 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to
2 increasing the salaries of magistrates.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 1. COURTS AND OFFICERS.

§50-1-3. Salaries of magistrates.

1 Notwithstanding any provisions of this code to the contrary, beginning July 1, 2021, the
2 annual salary of a magistrate shall be \$60,375, and beginning July 1, 2022, the annual salary of a
3 magistrate shall be \$63,250. Beginning July 1, 2026, the annual salary of a magistrate shall be
4 \$70,000.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to increase the salaries of magistrates to \$70,000 annually, beginning July 1, 2026.
