1 A BILL finding and declaring certain claims against the state and its agencies to be moral  
2 obligations of the state; and directing the Auditor to issue warrants for the payment thereof.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**§1. Finding and declaring certain claims against the Department of Education; Department of Health and Human Resources; Department of Health Facilities; Division of Corrections; Division of Highways; Division of Motor Vehicles; and West Virginia Army National Guard, to be moral obligations of the state and directing payment thereof.**

1 The Legislature has considered the findings of fact and recommendations reported to it  
2 by the Legislative Claims Commission concerning various claims against the state and agencies  
3 thereof and, in respect to each of the following claims, the Legislature adopts those findings of  
4 fact as its own and in respect of the claims herein, the Legislature has independently made  
5 findings of fact and determinations of award and hereby declares it to be the moral obligation of  
6 the state to pay each such claim in the amount specified below and directs the Auditor to issue  
7 warrants for the payment thereof out of any fund appropriated and available for the purpose.

8           The Legislature finds that the above moral obligations and the appropriations made in  
9           satisfaction thereof shall be the full compensation for all claimants and that prior to the payments  
10          to any claimant provided in this bill, the Legislative Claims Commission shall receive a release  
11          from said claimant releasing any and all claims for moral obligations arising from the matters  
12          considered by the Legislature in the finding of the moral obligations and the making of the  
13          appropriations for said claimant. The Legislative Claims Commission shall deliver all releases  
14          obtained from claimants to the department against which the claim was allowed.
