1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to
2 authorizing the Board of Medicine to promulgate a legislative rule relating to continuing
3 education for physicians and podiatric physicians.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS BOARDS AND AGENCIES TO
PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-9-1. Board of Medicine.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 25, 2025, authorized under the
2 authority of §30-3-7 of this code, relating to the Board of Medicine (continuing education for
3 physicians and podiatric physicians, [11 CSR 06](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Medicine to promulgate a legislative rule relating to continuing education for physicians and podiatric physicians.
