A BILL making a supplementary appropriation of public moneys out of the Treasury from the balance of moneys remaining unappropriated for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2026, to the Department of Administration, Board of Risk and Insurance Management, Premium Tax Savings Fund, fund 2367, fiscal year 2026, organization 0218 by supplementing and amending the appropriations for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2026. WHEREAS, The Governor has established that there now remains an unappropriated balance in the Department of Administration, Board of Risk and Insurance Management – Premium Tax Savings Fund, fund 2367, fiscal year 2026, organization 0218, that is available for expenditure during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2026, which is hereby appropriated by the terms of this supplementary appropriation bill; therefore

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That the total appropriation for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2026, to fund 2367, fiscal year 2026, organization 0218, be supplemented and amended by adding a new item of appropriation as follows:
