### **Senate Bill 943**

1 A BILL to repeal §49-5-106 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to repealing  
2 the data collection code section relating to the Supreme Court of Appeals, the Division of  
3 Juvenile Services, the Department of Human Services, and the Department of Education,  
4 jointly collecting and compiling data as the Juvenile Justice Reform Oversight Committee  
5 sunset on December 31, 2020.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 5. RECORD KEEPING AND DATABASE.**

**§49-5-106. Data Collection**

1 [Repealed.]

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to repeal a section dealing with data collection for the Juvenile Reform Oversight Committee, which terms have expired due to a sunset provision.
