### **House Bill 4607**

- 1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,  
2 designated §18-28-8, relating to ensuring equal treatment of private and parochial schools  
3 for school building construction.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 28. PRIVATE, PAROCHIAL OR CHURCH SCHOOLS, OR SCHOOLS OF A  
RELIGIOUS ORDER.**

**§18-28-8. Equal treatment of private and parochial schools for school building  
construction.**

- 1 (a) Legislative findings. – The Legislature finds that private and parochial schools have  
2 recently been treated differently and held to more rigorous restraints than public schools in this  
3 state relating to the process of the construction and building of schools. The standards are very  
4 different between public schools and private schools for the process of the build of these facilities.  
5 (b) Implementation. – Any state permitting agency, county regulations, or municipality  
6 regulations for construction must treat private and parochial schools the same as public schools  
7 are treated. This includes, but is not limited to, the following: building permits, fees charged, safety  
8 standards, wastewater management, septic systems, the timeliness of permitting processes, and  
9 associated build requirements.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to ensure equal treatment of private and parochial schools  
for school building construction.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law  
and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
