1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding a new article,
 2 designated §46A-9-1, relating to requiring that all American flags sold for retail in the state
 3 are made in America.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 46A. WEST VIRGINIA CONSUMER CREDIT AND PROTECTION ACT.

§46A-9-1. Sale of American flags.

1 No person in the business of offering goods at retail may sell or offer for sale in this state an
 2 American flag unless the flag was manufactured in the United States of America.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require that all American flags sold for retail in the state are made in America.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
