

SENATE RESOLUTION 44

(By Senator Woelfel)

[Introduced February 16, 2026]

1 Recognizing and honoring the St. Joseph Central Catholic High School Fighting Irish Boys
2 Soccer Team for its outstanding 2025 season and State Championship title.

3 Whereas, The St. Joseph Central Catholic High School Fighting Irish Boys Soccer Team
4 completed an extraordinary 2025 season, achieving an overall record of 23 wins and only 2
5 losses while competing against AAAA-level competition; and

6 Whereas, The team was led with distinction by Head Coach Nick Turner, Assistant
7 Coach Brandon Stacy, Trainer Mike Callanan, and Athletic Director and Principal Dr. Carol
8 Templeton, whose leadership, preparation, and commitment to excellence guided the program
9 to historic success; and

10 Whereas, The team's captains—Brier Wagner, Carter Woelfel, and Patrick Kelly—
11 provided exceptional leadership on and off the field, setting the tone for discipline, teamwork,
12 and competitive spirit; and

13 Whereas, The Fighting Irish demonstrated remarkable resilience and competitive
14 strength throughout the season, culminating in a commanding 4–0 victory over Wheeling
15 Central in the State Final; and

16 Whereas, In that championship match, Brier Wagner and Liam Templeton each scored
17 two goals, securing the title even as the team finished the match playing 11 versus 9 after being
18 reduced by two players—an extraordinary display of determination, composure, and unity; and

19 Whereas, The 2025 Fighting Irish roster represents a talented and dedicated group of
