- 1 A BILL to repeal §24-2F-8 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to net
2 metering and internet connection standards.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 2F. ALTERNATIVE AND RENEWABLE ENERGY PORTFOLIO STANDARD.

§1. Repeal of section related to net metering and interconnection standards.

- 1 That §24-2F-8 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended is repealed.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to eliminate net metering of public utilities.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law
and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
