1 A BILL to amend and reenact §7-7-4 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to  
2 compensation of elected officials; and increasing the salaries of Sheriffs 10% more than  
3 the salaries of the County Clerk and Circuit Clerk.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

## **ARTICLE 7. COMPENSATION OF ELECTED COUNTY OFFICIALS.**

### **§7-7-4. Compensation of elected county officials and county commissioners for each class of county; effective date.**

1 (1) The increased salaries to be paid to the county commissioners and the other elected  
2 county officials described in this section on and after July 1, 2014, and on and after July 1, 2022,  
3 are set out in subsections (5) and (7) of this section. Every county commissioner and elected  
4 county official in each county, whose term of office commenced prior to or on or after July 1, 2014,  
5 shall receive the same annual salary by virtue of legislative findings of extra duties as set forth in  
6 §7-7-1 of this code.

7 (2) Before the increased salaries, as set out in subsections (5) and (7) of this section, are  
8 paid to the county commissioners and the elected county officials, the following requirements must  
9 be met:

10 (A) The Auditor has certified that the fiscal condition of the county, considering costs,  
11 revenues, liabilities, and significant trends of the same; maintenance standards; and the  
12 commitment to the provision of county services has sufficiently improved over the previous fiscal  
13 years so that there exists an amount sufficient for the payment of the increase in the salaries set  
14 out in subsections (5) and (7) of this section and the related employment taxes: *Provided*, That the  
15 Auditor may not provide the certification for the payment of the increase in the salaries where any  
16 proposed annual county budget contains anticipated receipts which are unreasonably greater or  
17 lesser than that of the previous year. For purposes of this subsection, the term "receipts" does not  
18 include unencumbered fund balance or federal or state grants: *Provided, however*, That the  
19 Auditor shall not be held liable for relying upon information and data provided by a county

20 commission in assessing the county's fiscal condition or a proposed annual county budget; and  
21 (B) Each county commissioner or other elected official described in this section in office on  
22 the effective date of the increased salaries provided by this section who desires to receive the  
23 increased salary shall have prior to that date filed in the office of the clerk of the county commission  
24 his or her written request for the salary increase. The salary for the person who holds the office of  
25 county commissioner or other elected official described in this section who fails to file the written  
26 request as required by this subdivision shall be the salary for that office in effect immediately prior  
27 to the effective date of the increased salaries provided by this section until the person vacates the  
28 office or his or her term of office expires, whichever first occurs.

29 Any request for a salary increase shall use the following language:

30 I, [name of office holder], the duly elected [name of office] in and for the County of [name of  
31 county], West Virginia, do hereby request a salary increase pursuant to W. Va. Code §7-7-4 of this  
32 code, as amended. This salary increase is effective ( \_\_\_\_\_ ).

35 (3) If the Auditor has failed to certify that there is an amount sufficient for the payment of the  
36 increase in the salaries and the related employment taxes pursuant to this section, then the  
37 salaries of that county's elected officials and commissioners shall remain at the level in effect at  
38 the time certification was sought.

39 (4) In any county having a tribunal in lieu of a county commission, the county  
40 commissioners of that county may be paid less than the minimum salary limits of the county  
41 commission for that particular class of the county.

88        (8) Any county clerk, circuit clerk, county assessor, prosecuting attorney, or sheriff of a  
 89        Class I through Class V county, inclusive, any assessor or any sheriff of a Class VI through Class  
 90        IX county, inclusive, shall devote full time to his or her public duties to the exclusion of any other  
 91        employment: *Provided*, That any public official whose term of office begins when his or her  
 92        county's classification imposes no restriction on his or her outside activities may not be restricted  
 93        on his or her outside activities during the remainder of the term for which he or she is elected.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to raise the salary of Sheriff's to be 10% above the salaries of the county clerk and circuit clerk.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
