- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §17A-10-3c of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,
2 relating to increasing registration fees for alternative fuel vehicles.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 10. FEES FOR REGISTRATION, LICENSING, ETC.

§17A-10-3c. Additional registration fees for alternative fuel vehicles.

- 1 (a) The annual registration fee for a vehicle fueled with hydrogen or natural gas is \$200
2 \$400.
- 3 (b) The annual registration fee for a vehicle operating on a combination of electricity and
4 petrochemical fuels is ~~\$100~~ \$200.
- 5 (c) The annual registration fee for a vehicle operating exclusively on electricity is \$200
6 \$400.
- 7 (d) The fees imposed by this section are in addition to any other fee set forth in this article.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to increase the registration fees for alternative fuel vehicles.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
