Pursuant to the call of the Chair, the Senate Committee on Education met on March 1, 2019 at 9:00am in Room 451-M.

The Clerk took a silent roll call to establish quorum.

On the motion of Senator Blair, the minutes of the February 26, 2019 meeting were approved.

HB 2363-Relating to the Upper Kanawha Valley Resiliency and Revitalization Program

Hank Hager, Counsel, explained the committee amendment in lieu of having it read.
