Pursuant to the call of the Chairman, the Senate Committee on the Judiciary met on January 16, 2019, at 3:00 p.m. in Room 208-W.

All members being present, with the exception of Senator Takubo, who was absent, the Chairman declared the presence of a quorum. (See attached roll call and agenda).

On motion of Senator Weld, the minutes of the previous meeting were approved.

S. B. 62 - Requiring participation in drug court program before discharge of certain first-time drug offenses.

Tom Smith, Chief Counsel, explained the bill, the purpose of the proposed committee substitute, and responded to questions.

On motion of Senator Weld, the committee amended the committee substitute on page 1, line 3, by adding the words "listed in §60A-2-204 of this code other than marijuana or is a controlled substance listed in §60A-2-206, §60A-2-208, or §60A-2-210 of this code which contains" before the word "an".

On motion of Senator Weld, the committee agreed to the committee substitute as amended.

On motion of Senator Weld, the committee reported the committee substitute to the full Senate with the recommendation that it do pass.


S. B. 240 - Repealing certain legislative rules no longer authorized or are obsolete.

Debra Graham, Counsel, explained the bill, the purpose of the proposed committee substitute, and responded to questions.


On motion of Senator Weld, the committee agreed to the committee substitute.
