Minutes for February 27, 2024, 10:00 AM

Pursuant to the call of the Chair, the Senate Committee on Education met on February 27, 2024, 10:00 AM in Room 451-M.

Members absent: Senators Plymale, Trump

A silent roll call being taken, the presence of a quorum was established.

On motion of Vice-Chair Clements, the minutes of the previous meeting were approved.

The next item on the agenda was **HB4814** - Relating to extending the reporting and sunset dates of the State Advisory Council on Postsecondary Attainment Goals.

Chair Grady recognized Hank Hager, Counsel, to explain the bill in lieu of having it read. The bill was explained.

Chair Grady recognized Vice-Chair Clements for the purpose of making a motion. Vice-Chair Clements moved that **House Bill 4814** be reported to the full Senate with the recommendation that it do pass. The motion was adopted.

The next item on the agenda was **HB4838** - Require county boards of education to provide long-term substitute teachers, upon hiring, with certain information.

Chair Grady recognized Hank Hager, Counsel, to explain the bill in lieu of having it read. The bill and the Committee Amendment were both explained.

Chair Grady recognized Vice-Chair Clements for the purpose of making a motion. Vice-Chair Clements moved the Committee Amendment as explained by Counsel. The motion was adopted.

Chair Grady recognized Vice-Chair Clements for the purpose of making a motion. Vice-Chair Clements moved that **House Bill 4838, as amended**, be reported to the full Senate with the recommendation that it do pass. The motion was adopted.


Chair Grady recognized Vice-Chair Clements for the purpose of making a motion. Vice-Chair Clements moved the Title Amendment. The motion was adopted.
