#### Minutes for February 20, 2024, 1:00 PM

Pursuant to the call of the Chair, the Senate Committee on Health and Human Resources met on February 20, 2024, 1:00 PM in Room 451-M.

A silent roll call being taken, the presence of a quorum was established.

On motion of Senator Tarr, the minutes of the previous meeting were approved.

Chairman Maroney recognized Ryan Vick, Counsel, Senate Health and Human Resources, who explained Senate Bill 528 and the committee substitute. The language of the committee substitute was agreed to. Senator Tarr moved that the Committee Substitute for Senate Bill 528 be reported to the full Senate with recommendation that it do pass, but under the original double committee reference, first be referred to the Committee on The Judiciary. The motion carried.

Chairman Maroney recognized Cindy Dellinger, Counsel, Senate Health and Human Resources, who explained Senate Bill 672 and the committee substitute. The language of the committee substitute was agreed to. Senator Tarr moved that the Committee Substitute for Senate Bill 672 be reported to the full Senate with the recommendation that it do pass, but under the original double committee reference, first be referred to the Committee on Finance. The motion carried.

Chairman Maroney recognized Cindy Dellinger, Counsel, Senate Health and Human Resources, who explained Senate Bill 743 and the committee substitute. The language of the committee substitute was agreed to. Senator Tarr moved that the Committee Substitute for Senate Bill 743 be reported to the full Senate with recommendation that it do pass. The motion carried.

Chairman Maroney recognized Ryan Vick, Counsel, Senate Health and Human Resources, who explained Senate Bill 769 and the committee substitute. The language of the committee substitute was agreed to. Senator Tarr moved that the Committee Substitute for Senate

Bill 769 be reported to the full Senate with the recommendation that it do pass, but under the original double committee reference, first be referred to the committee on The Judiciary. The motion carried.

Chairman Maroney recognized Cindy Dellinger, Counsel, Senate Health and Human Resources, who explained Senate Bill 796 and the committee substitute. Senator Tarr moved to lay the bill over to a subsequent meeting of the Senate Health and Human Resources Committee. By voice vote, the motion carried.


