Committee on Education

Minutes for March 25, 2025, 9:30 AM

Pursuant to the call of the Chair, the Senate Committee on Education met on March 25, 2025, 9:30 AM in Room 451-M.

Members present: Senators Grady, Clements, Azinger, Bartlett, Deeds, Fuller, Hart, Morris, Oliverio, Roberts, Tarr, Taylor, Garcia

Members absent: Senators Boley, Stuart

A silent roll call being taken, the presence of a quorum was established.

On motion of Vice-Chair Clements, the minutes of the previous meeting were approved.

The next item on the agenda was **SB89** - Creating alternative high-risk population public charter schools.

Chair Grady recognized Hank Hager, Counsel, to explain the bill in lieu of having it read. The bill was explained. Questions and discussion from the Committee followed.

Chair Grady recognized Vice-Chair Clements for a motion. Vice-Chair Clements moved that **Senate Bill 89** be reported to the full Senate with the recommendation that it do pass, but under the original double committee reference first be referred to the **Committee on Finance**. The motion was adopted.

The next item on the agenda was **SB881** - Modifying authority of certain higher education entities to sell and transfer property.

Chair Grady recognized Hank Hager, Counsel, to explain the bill in lieu of having it read. The bill was explained. Discussion from the Committee followed.

Chair Grady recognized Vice-Chair Clements for a motion. Vice-Chair Clements moved that **Senate Bill 881** be reported to the full Senate with the recommendation that it do pass, but under the original double committee reference first be referred to the **Committee on Government Organization**. The motion was adopted.

The next item on the agenda was **SB529** - Relating generally to liability insurance coverage for Board of Education.

Chair Grady recognized Hank Hager, Counsel, to explain the Committee Substitute in lieu of having it read. The Committee Substitute was explained. A question and discussion from the Committee followed.

By voice vote, the Committee Substitute was agreed to.

Chair Grady recognized Vice-Chair Clements for a motion. Vice-Chair Clements moved that the **Committee Substitute for Senate Bill 529** be reported to the full Senate with the recommendation that it do pass, but under the original double committee reference first be referred to the **Committee on Finance**. The motion was adopted.

The next item on the agenda was **SB866** - Requiring WV Board of Education to promulgate legislative rule in consultation with WV Board of Physical Therapy.

Chair Grady recognized Hank Hager, Counsel, to explain the bill in lieu of having it read. The bill was explained.

Chair Grady recognized Vice-Chair Clements for a motion. Vice-Chair Clements moved that **Senate Bill 866** be reported to the full Senate with the recommendation that it do pass. The motion was adopted.

The next item on the agenda was **SB911** - Relating to adjunct teaching permits.

Chair Grady recognized Hank Hager, Counsel, to explain the Committee Substitute in lieu of having it read. The Committee Substitute was explained. Questions and discussion from the Committee followed.



Mr. Gladkosky proceeded to answer a question from the Committee. By voice vote, the amendment was adopted.

Chair Grady recognized Senator Deeds. Senator Deeds offered a Conceptual Amendment. Counsel understood the amendment. By voice vote, the amendment was adopted.


By voice vote, the Committee Substitute, as amended, was agreed to.

Chair Grady recognized Vice-Chair Clements for a motion. Vice-Chair Clements moved that the **Committee Substitute for Senate Bill 911, as amended**, be reported to the full Senate with the recommendation that it do pass. The motion was adopted.

On motion of Vice-Chair Clements, the Committee adjourned.
