Minutes for February 20, 2025, 1:00 PM

Pursuant to the call of the Chair, the Senate Committee on Health and Human Resources met on February 20, 2025, 1:00 PM in Room 451-M.

A silent roll call being taken, the presence of a quorum was established.

On motion of Senator Deeds, the minutes of the previous meeting were approved.

Senator Chapman recognized Cindy Dellinger, Counsel, Senate Health and Human Resources, who explained Senate Bill 92. Senator Deeds moved that Senate Bill 92 be reported to the full Senate with recommendation that it do pass. The motion carried.

Senator Chapman recognized Jenna Fonner, Counsel, Senate Health and Human Resources, who explained Senate Bill 291. Senator Deeds moved that Senate Bill 291 be reported to the full Senate with recommendation that it do pass. The motion carried.

Senator Chapman recognized Cindy Dellinger, Counsel, Senate Health and Human Resources, who explained Senate Bill 292.

With leave of Committee, Senator Chapman recognized Lara McCormick and administered the oath pursuant to Senate Rule 28a. Ms. McCormick answered questions from the Committee.

Senator Deeds moved that Senate Bill 292 be reported to the full Senate with recommendation that it do pass, but under the original double committee reference, first be referred to the Committee on Finance. The motion carried.

Senator Chapman recognized Cindy Dellinger, Counsel, Senate Health and Human Resources, who explained Senate Bill 430 and the Committee Substitute. The language of the Committee Substitute was agreed to. Senator Deeds moved that the Committee Substitute be reported to the full Senate with recommendation that it do pass, but under the original double committee reference, first be referred to the Committee on Finance. The motion carried.

Senator Chapman recognized Jenna Fonner, Counsel, Senate Health and Human Resources, who explained Senate Bill 526 and answered questions from the Committee.


