Minutes for April 07, 2025, 2:30 PM

Pursuant to the call of the Chair, the Senate Committee on Health and Human Resources met on April 07, 2025, 2:30 PM in Room 451-M.

Members absent: Senators Martin, Queen

A silent roll call being taken, the presence of a quorum was established.

On motion of Senator Deeds, the minutes of the previous meeting were approved.

Senator Chapman recognized Senator Deeds, who moved that the Committee reconsider the vote by which the Committee reported House Bill 2776, as amended. The motion carried. Senator Deeds requested unanimous consent to withdraw the motion to report. The motion carried. Senator Deeds moved that the Committee reconsider the vote by which the Committee adopted the strike and insert amendment to House Bill 2776. The motion carried. Senator Deeds requested unanimous consent to withdraw the strike and insert amendment to House Bill 2776. The motion carried.

Senator Chapman recognized Jenna Fonner, Counsel, Senate Health and Human Resources, who explained House Bill 2776 and the new proposed committee amendment. Counsel answered questions from the Committee. Senator Garcia raised a point of order relating to germaneness. The Chair overruled and rejected the point of order. Senator Deeds moved the amendment as explained by Counsel. Senator Takubo offered a conceptual amendment to the amendment. Counsel understood the amendment. Division was called. Roll Call was demanded. The demand was sustained. The amendment failed with 11 NAYS and 2 YEAS. Senator Rose offered a conceptual amendment to the amendment. Counsel understood the amendment. By voice vote, the amendment was adopted. Senator Deeds moved that House Bill 2776, as amended, be reported to the full Senate with recommendation that it do pass. The motion carried.

Senator Chapman recognized Jenna Fonner, Counsel, Senate Health and Human Resources, who explained House Bill 2797. Counsel answered questions from the Committee. Senator Takubo offered a conceptual amendment. Counsel understood the amendment. By voice

vote, the amendment was adopted. Senator Deeds moved that House Bill 2797, as amended, be reported to the full Senate with recommendation that it do pass. The motion carried.

Senator Deeds moved the amendment as explained by Counsel. By voice vote, the amendment was adopted. Senator Deeds moved that House Bill 2575, as amended, be reported to the full Senate with recommendation that it do pass, but under the original double committee reference, first be referred to the Committee on Finance. The motion carried.

Senator Chapman recognized Cindy Dellinger, Counsel, Senate Health and Human Resources, who explained House Bill 2349.

With leave of committee, Senator Chapman recognized Delegate Sarah Drennan, who delivered testimony to the Committee and answered questions. Senator Deeds moved that House Bill 2349 be reported to the full Senate with recommendation that it do pass, but under the original double committee reference, first be referred to the Committee on Finance. The motion carried.

Senator Chapman recognized Cindy Dellinger, Counsel, Senate Health and Human Resources, who explained House Bill 2351 and the proposed committee amendment. Senator Deeds moved the amendment as explained by Counsel. Counsel answered questions from the Committee. Senator Garcia requested a ruling pursuant to Senate Rule 43. Senator Chapman ruled that the Senator was a member of a class and would be required to vote. Senator Deeds moved that House Bill 2351 be reported to the full Senate with recommendation that it do pass, as amended, but under the original double committee reference, first be referred to the Committee on Finance. The motion carried.


