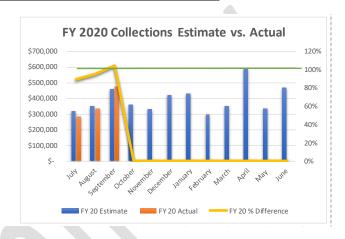

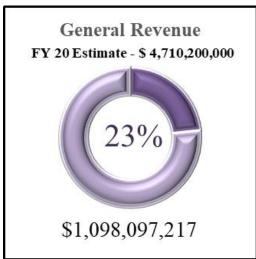
### **General Revenue**

General Revenue collections for September totaled \$477,269,017, **exceeding** the monthly estimate of \$457,241,000 by \$20,028,017. Bringing the total year to date General Revenue collections to \$1,098,097,217.

As of the end of September the state has collected 23% of its total estimated yearly revenue of \$4,710,200,000. At this time, the state should have collected 24% of its yearly revenue. This current trend puts the state **not on track** for meeting yearly revenue estimates.

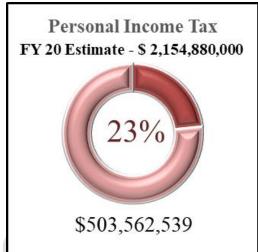
### **Personal Income Tax**

Personal income tax (PIT) collections for the month were \$226,744,767. This figure is \$244,767 **below** the September estimate of \$226,500,000. The total year to date personal income tax collections for fiscal year 2020 are \$503,562,539.

As of the end of September the state has collected 23% of its total estimated PIT yearly collections of \$2,154,880,000. At this time the state should have collected 24% of its PIT yearly collections. This current trend puts the state **not on track** for meeting the PIT yearly collections estimate.

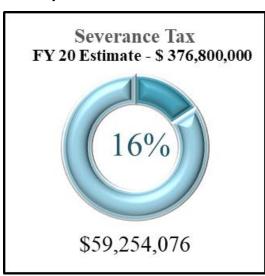
#### **Severance Tax**

Severance tax collections for September were \$33,911,290. This figure is \$411,290 **above** the monthly estimate of \$33,500,000. Total severance tax collections for fiscal year 2020 are \$59,254,076.

As of the end of September the state has collected 16% of its total yearly collections of \$376,800,000. At this time the state should have collected 23% of its yearly severance tax collections. This current trend puts the state **not on track** for meeting the yearly severance tax collection estimate.

### **Other Notable Collections**

Consumer Sales and Service Tax collections for the month were \$1,620,229 **above** the September estimate of \$124,200,000 at \$125,820,229.

Tobacco Products Tax collections for September were \$13,255,683. These collections were **below** the monthly estimate of \$14,800,000 by \$1,544,317.

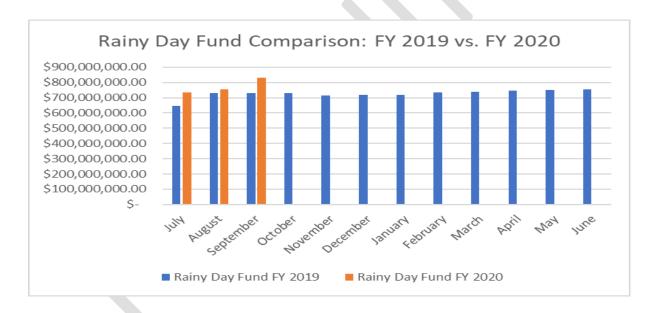

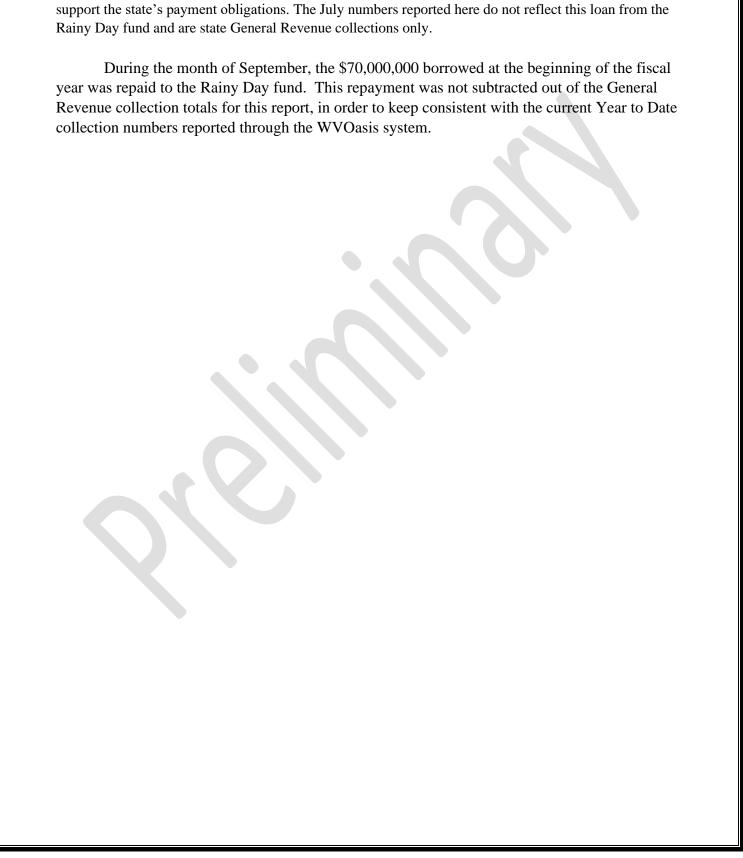

# **Notes on General Revenue Collections**

On June 28, 2019 the Governor, pursuant to \$11B-2-20(e), borrowed \$70,000,000 from the Rainy Day fund to make adequate and timely payments of the state's obligations for the beginning of the fiscal year. This amount will be repaid by the end of September when current state revenues are adequate to support the state's payment obligations. The July numbers reported here do not reflect this loan from the Rainy Day fund and are state General Revenue collections only.
