**Justice Walker's Response to the Honorable Ronald E. Wilson's
Motion to Quash the House of Delegates' Subpoena**

No testimony from the Honorable Ronald E. Wilson will tend to make any fact on the ultimate issue — whether Justice Walker committed a removable offense — more or less probable. *See* W. Va. R. Evid. 401. Justice Walker takes no position on the motion to quash. But since any testimony sought is irrelevant, the House Managers should withdraw the subpoena to Judge Wilson so that the motion to quash may be denied as moot.
