## Stock Epinephrine and Narcan in WV Public Schools January 2024



Pursuant to the provisions of W. Va. Code §18-5-22c(i) and §18-5-22d(f), all county boards of education are required to collect and compile aggregate data on incidents of anaphylactic and opioid reactions resulting in the administration of school-maintained epinephrine auto-injectors and opioid antagonist in during the school year; therefore, WVDE submits the following data for the 2022-2023 school year:

- » All 55 counties documented the required information.
- » 10 Stock Epinephrine Auto-Injectors were administered.
- » 4 Stock Opioid Antagonists were administered.
