Dear Mr. President and Mr. Speaker:

Pursuant to the authority provided by West Virginia Code §12-4-14, as amended, we have completed an audit of the Franklin Volunteer Fire Department's state funds for the period of January 1, 2013 through January 30, 2015. Located in Pendleton County, the Department began 2013 with a balance of \$14,002.10 in its state account. The Department received additional monies from the State in the amount of \$45,010.58 in 2013 and \$23,857.57 in 2014; therefore, the audit included \$82,870.25 in state funding.

The objective of the audit was to evaluate compliance with West Virginia Code §8-15-8b, as amended. We concluded the Department was in compliance, accounting for all state funding except \$703.00 that lacked adequate documentation to determine for what purpose the money was spent. The Legislative Auditor recommends the Department reimburse its state account \$703.00 or provide adequate documentation to verify the expenditures were in accordance with WV Code.
